In an interview, companies might ask you questions about:

- 1. Your educational background
- 2. Your work and volunteer experience
- 3. Your personality
- 4. Your communication and social skills
- 5. Your teamwork skills
- 6. Your ability to cope with stress and frustration
- 7. Your ability to solve work-related problems

They might not ask you questions about all of these skills, but it is better to be prepared!
