Page 1

"Tell me a little bit about yourself."	"Why are you interested in this position?"
"Tell me about any work experience you have had."	"Do you have any experience working in ?" (name specific area to which student plans to apply)
"If you are employed, why do you want to leave your current job?"	"If you were previously employed, why did you leave your previous position?"
"What is your availability?"	"Are you seeking full time or part time employment?"
"When could you start working if you were hired?"	"If hired, how long are you planning to stay in this position?"



## Responding to Interview Questions Scenarios Page 2

"What are some of your strengths?"	"What are some of your weaknesses?"
"Do you enjoy working with others?"	"What's the best part about working with a group or team?"
"What's the most challenging part about working with a group or team?"	"Some people are not so easy to get along with. Tell me about a time you had to work with someone in school or on the job who was difficult to deal with."
"Tell me about a time when you had a difficult project or assignment and you were not sure what to do about it. How did you handle it?"	"How do you handle really frustrating or stressful situations?"
"Do you enjoy helping people?"	"What questions do you have for me?"
